The Government works with various community partners to prevent offending and reoffending.

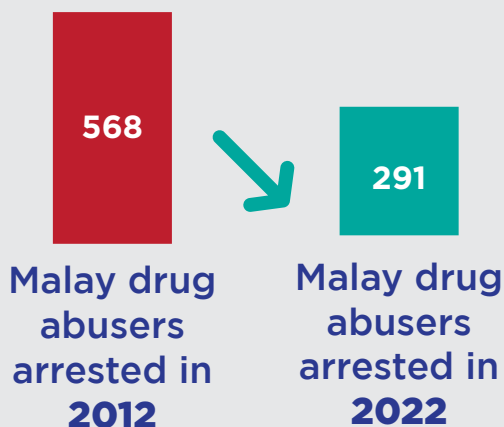
Besides broad-based programmes, MHA works with community partners to develop culturally-nuanced programmes to address specific needs of different races and religions.
